**Use these words to compare items:**

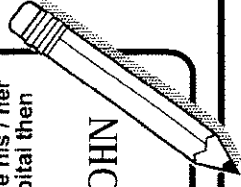

ex. **J**ohn not **JOHN**



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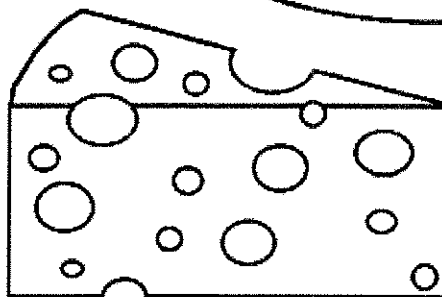
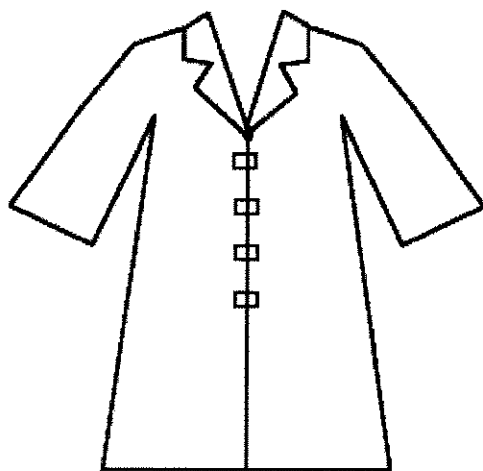
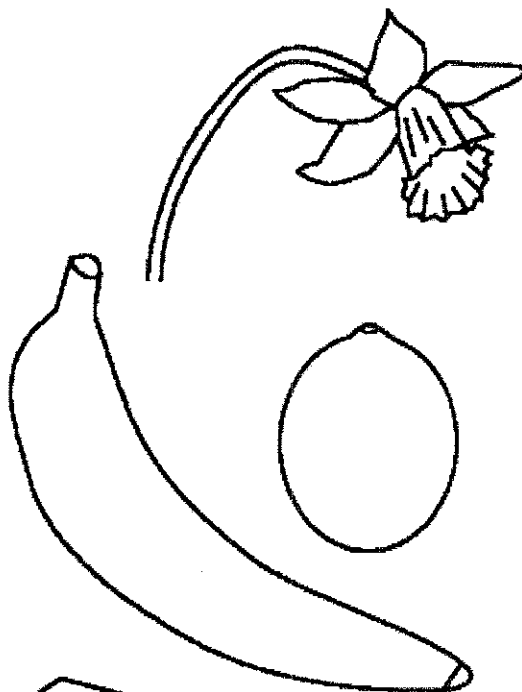
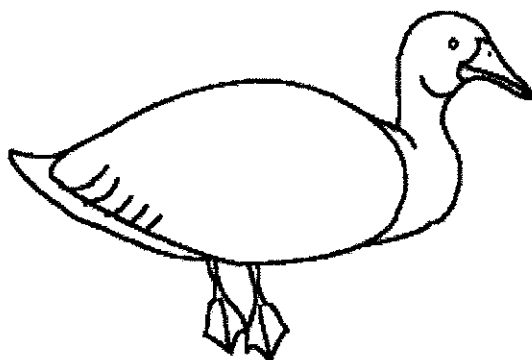
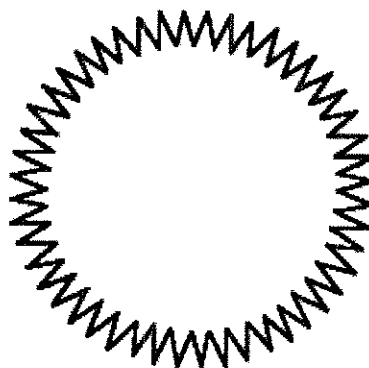
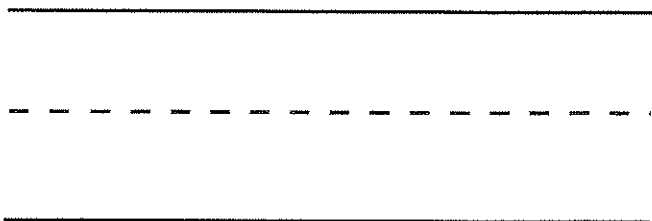
